

Some thoughts about Lent and a challenge for discipleship from UCC.org:

After calling the crowd together with his disciples, Jesus said to

them, "All who want to come after me must say no to themselves, take up their cross,

and follow me...."

Mark 8:34

During the season of Lent, Christians have historically focused on repentance, reflection, and humility. That intention has encouraged practices, such as fasting, giving up something and other spiritual disciplines ...in the way of sacrificial living modeled by Jesus.

In that spirit, Christians may also elect to take on a new practice rather than letting go ... The question is not whether we will give something up or take something on. Rather, the imperative of the moment is to say no to what needs to be discarded to make space ("to say yes") for what we will gain. In this season of Lent, we will commit to say "no"... (so we can say yes!).


