Easter Tide....

The resurrection of Jesus, said Dr. Stookey, "is the manifestation of a new kind and quality of life, which we have no words to describe. If we think we can understand it, we do not understand it at all. For resurrection is the sublime, mysterious gift of God, which we are to experience as both astounding and transforming."

We do not know for sure if Eastertide lasted exactly 50 days, or if the Bible indicates that Jesus was with his disciples for an extended period of time after the resurrection. Our transformation times both individually and as church, tend to take much longer, and it is often that we experience God's presence in these transformations only when we look back and exclaim: 'Oh!

God was truly with us. I take great comfort in the words of the poet Rilke: "Even at the times we do not see it, God is still ripening."

I pray that we experience this astounding and transformative power, individually and as a church, as we continue to come together and open ourselves to God's Spirit.

On the other hand, what better time to start then, moving together through this time of incredible transformation and new beginnings, which Easter represents. So, we settled on March 15th, and yes, we had some busy weeks, but it was also a wonderful way to get to know the community and get to see just how committed the church is and how willing everybody is to step in and step up. I am very grateful for the warm welcome I received and am very excited to continue with you on this next part of our jour-

The Trustees agreed in their April meeting that the church should sponsor a table for up to 8 people at the Marin Interfaith Council Annual Prayer Breakfast on May 1.

This is a large event of several hundred from the religious community in Marin, gathered at Congregation Kol Shofar synagogue in Tiburon. The meeting includes Christians, Muslims, Jews, Buddhists, and others.

Have you noticed the little garden at the church entrance on the left? One of Lynn Grant's last gifts to the church were the short iron fences which now protect the plantings. Previous plantings have had hard lives because they got stepped on, but the fence has stopped that and the plants are thriving.
